This year, the day will be marked by an outdoor gathering with drumming and

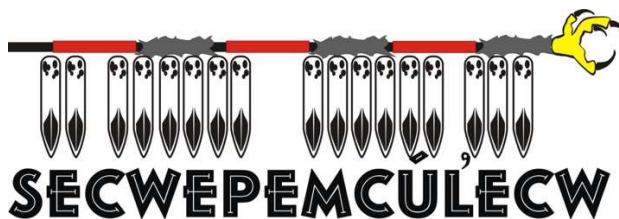
storytelling.

PARENT INPUT REQUEST FOR STUDENT PLACEMENTS FOR 2024-2025:

Each May and June teachers meet to organize classes with considerations given to gender balance, learning needs, teaching styles, social dynamics, academic groupings, class size limits and where possible, parental requests. Moreover, tentative class lists are made through staff conversations first before parental requests are looked at. However, for those families who have significant concerns about their child's educational placement, we invite you to come to the school and pick up a PINK PARENT INPUT form and return it by May 16, 2024 indicating the educational reasons for your request. While this simply gives parents a chance to advocate for their child and their educational needs, it by no means guarantees that your request will be honoured so please keep this in mind. Ultimately, the SCHOOL ACT, gives the principal the final say on any child's placement in their school. Ms. Flynn will have these in the office for pick up starting Wednesday April 3rd, 2024. Please fill out one per child and please note that name requesting a particular teacher you want or do not want is not the intent of this process.

ARE YOU MOVING for 2024-2025?

Parents of Aberdeen Elementary that plan to move for September 2024 should contact Ms. Flynn as soon as possible and let her know your plans to relocate. Our classes are extremely full so knowing we potentially have spots in K-7 would be extremely helpful as we plan for the upcoming school year.

STUDENT TRANSFER REQUESTS

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE:

Parents who are not in our catchment area, but would like their child to attend Aberdeen Elementary, must register at their home school. Once registered there, a parent can fill out a STUDENT TRANSFER FORM and have the principal of the home school sign it so that he/she is aware that they would like to be enrolled elsewhere. For September 2024, parents would not find out if their child had been granted a transfer until the Friday of the first week of school. For more information about this procedure, parents can go to the School District #73 website and follow the links to our public Administrative Procedures. AP 305 SCHOOL BOUNDARIES AND STUDENT TRANSFER REQUESTS is clearly written and gives a detailed explanation.

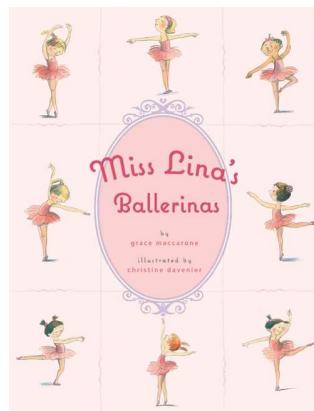
Overdue Books:

SAFE ARRIVAL

Aberdeen uses an automated SAFE ARRIVAL SYSTEM called SCHOOL MESSENGER. The system handles parent contact (including phone calls) when a student absence is unexpected, and will allow parents to interact directly with the system in a variety of ways:

- by phone either when the system calls, or when a parent initiates a call to notify of upcoming absence
- by internet through login controlled webpage interface
- by smartphone app (iOS and Android versions available for free)

Parents use the above methods to report student absences rather than phoning the school at Aberdeen. **We ask that parents please report student absences before 8:30 am on the day of the absence**, although the system also allows for reporting of student absences long in advance for holidays, trips, etc. For tech-savvy parents, we encourage you to download the iOS or Android apps for free from their respective app stores. To find the app, search for SCHOOL MESSENGER and install the free app.

Please always be sure to inform the teacher of your child's absence as well so that they are aware of any sickness or trips planned and to plan for instruction missed.

MYEDBC PARENT PORTAL

If parents have not created a Parent Portal in MYEDBC you need to do that. Report cards will only be published to the portal again this year. Parents will NOT receive a paper copy so this is very important. Here are the instructions to do this ASAP if you put it off last year:

Each parent or guardian or household will have their own separate account.

To Access the MyEducation BC System

1. Visit www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen
2. Make sure popups are enabled for your browser.
3. Your user name (LOGIN ID) will be: (the email you gave the school)
4. Your temporary password would have been sent to you via email. Should you not remember your password, click on the "I forgot my password" link and follow the instructions) (**NOTE: Both user name and password are case sensitive. New Password requirements: Must be at least 8 characters, including a capital letter, a symbol and a number.**)
5. Enter your user name (LOGIN ID) and password then click "Log On" to access the system. You may be prompted to change your password and fill out some information so that in the future you can click "I forgot my password" to receive a new password if you haven't already

Once inside the MyEducation BC system you can navigate around to view information for your student(s).

REGISTER FOR KEV SCHOOL CASH

Re: KEV Group, *SchoolCash Online* for Student Fees

To: Parents/Guardians

Our School District has engaged the services of KEV Group, a company offering a web-based software solution, *SchoolCash Online* which includes several modules designed to meet the financial needs of K-12 public education schools. With Ministerial mandates for improvement and recommendations from our external auditors, School District No. 73 is looking to using a digital product, to manage our school fees and accounting.

The intention is to replace/reduce the use of cash and the use of the historic accounting system in our schools.

As a result, the School District's Finance Department and schools have been working with *SchoolCash Online* to implement a digital system connecting parents and students. This system provides an easy method of paying your child's school fees for courses, field trips, sports teams, clubs and many other student activities anytime, anywhere in a safe and secure web-based environment.

While recognizing the benefits of this payment environment, you must also be aware of the potential impacts and risks of sharing digital information online and of the necessity to protect our students' personal information regardless of where it is stored or accessed. As a public body, we are subject to the *BC Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. In accordance with this Act, we must at all time protect the privacy of students under our care.

NOON HOUR SUPERVISORS

We are always looking for parents who would be interested in becoming volunteers for the 2023-2024 school year on a regular or on-call basis. Noon hour supervision duties do receive a small honorarium pay. Please know that a Criminal Record check is required.

CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS

ALL PARENTS/GRANDPARENTS/ADULTS that are going on ANY trip with your class, are driving as volunteers or are coming into support with class special events must have a CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK. This is of no cost to the adult but is site specific for our school. CRC's last 3 years and remain on file for Ms. Flynn and teachers to check when they expire for you.

The cost of the coverage is \$39.95 monthly (for all family members). The product is annually renewed and can be purchased any time of the year for the monthly fee of \$39.95.

PARKING MATTERS AT ABERDEEN

Just a reminder to all parents/guardians and in particular our new families of the letter that is used to reinforce parking matters at Aberdeen Elementary. RE: Transit Impacts- Parking Concerns (Aberdeen Elementary School)

Due to concerns in your neighbourhood, the City of Kamloops and Kamloops Transit is reminding you that bus stops are **designated as no stopping zones**. Students may not be picked-up and dropped-off within signed no stopping zones.

The current traffic bylaw states that **parking and stopping are prohibited within 20 metres on the near side to 7.5 metres on the far side of any bus stop sign** as shown below. Parking in signed no stopping areas is prohibited.

Please obey all bus stop and no stopping signs near the school. Blocking these spaces causes delays, prevents transit from accessing stops (including students boarding or exiting the bus), and presents accessibility issues.

This bylaw applies to all bus stops within the City of Kamloops. More information can be found under City of Kamloops Traffic Bylaw 23-30. Please provide this information to school staff, parents, and guardians. If concerns persist, Community Services may be dispatched for education a

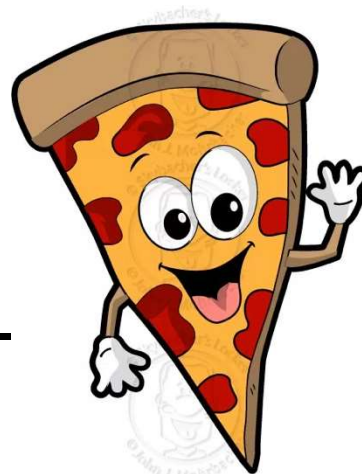
